TRAIL RESIDENCY PROGRAM INFORMATION SHEET WILLI KRAUSE FIELDHOUSE USER GROUPS

Effective September 14, 2016

This information pertains to all user groups of the Willi Krause Fieldhouse for the upcoming 2016/2017 season.

- **All participants** must have a residency card, a sport pass, or a tourist pass to participate in an organized activity in any City of Trail facility at the TRP rate – those not having any of these cards will not be permitted to utilize the facilities or the user group can opt to be charged at the non TRP hourly rental rate for all their bookings.
- **Residents of Trail, Warfield, Beaver Valley (Montrose, Fruitvale, Electoral Area A) are required** to come in to the Parks & Recreation Department and complete the required application form (showing valid ID) and receive their card at no charge.
- **Anyone living in Rossland and Area B are required** to come in and purchase a sport pass, which is \$31.00 per participant.
- **Anyone living outside of Trail, Warfield, Electoral Areas B, Rossland, and Beaver Valley** can obtain a Tourist Sports Pass at no charge. Individuals are required to complete the application form (showing valid ID) and will receive their card at no charge.
- All cards/passes are available at the Parks & Recreation Office and must be processed prior to using the facility.

We will require your player rosters submitted to our Department no later than 30 days following your first booking and will need verification that everyone on the roster has one of the passes mentioned above. Each pass has an issued number on it – this number must be recorded by each individual's name on the roster. If this information is not received within the 30 days groups will automatically be charged the non TRP rental rate for all their bookings.
